

A VERY WARM WELCOME DESIGN NOTES

A Very Warm Welcome was originally a Panzerblitz scenario that was created by Micheal P. Flagiello and can be found on the Imaginative Strategist website. As keeping with my recent policy, I am placing Micheal's name in the Designer's Box on the scenario display. The scenario is really the prelude to the scenario Defensive Victory at Targul Frumos as it happens earlier the same day (2 May, 1944) and just a few miles north of it. It depicts the small battle of a German kampfguppe and the Russian advance guard which resulted in the Russian prematurely deploying their main force, thus buying time for the main German force further south to prepare (if only a few hours). The scenario was converted to East Front using the same standards as those scenarios of the Ode to Panzerblitz series on Games Depot.

For those who want to use the proper environmental and visibility conditions for the scenarios, the settings are as follows; Ground – Normal, Water – Normal, Trees – Normal, Fields – Plowed, and 15 hexes for maximum visibility.
